Rail traffic has right of way. Keep a distance of 1.5 m to the tracks.


Information about the site

Marl Chemical Park is one of the largest chemical sites in Germany. The site covers an area of about six square kilometers and the companies here employ approximately 10,000 people. Marl Chemical Park is operated by Evonik and is also the largest production site of Evonik, one of the world's leading specialty chemicals companies. In addition to Evonik, its subsidiaries, and affiliated companies, Marl Chemical Park is home to twelve other companies, which manufacture more than 4,000 products in about 100 plants.

Products produced at Marl Chemical Park include the following:

- Acrylic acid for hygiene products
- High-performance polymers used, for example, in medical devices
- Coatings for the automotive industry
- PVC for window profiles and flooring material
- Surfactants and glycols for laundry and cleaning products and cosmetics
- Polymer dispersions for carpets, latex mattresses
- Additives for coatings, colorants, and adhesives
- Liquid carbon dioxide for the beverage industry
- Polyamide 12 for 3D printers, for example

The more than four million tons of products produced each year in Marl are shipped all over the world. The site has more than 1,200 kilometers of internal pipelines on 30 kilometers of pipe bridges, 55 kilometers of roads, 70 kilometers of canal, and a rail network covering more than 100 kilometers.
